Whiskey (sometimes spelled whisky) is an amber-coloured, distilled spirit made out of fermented grain (most often rye, wheat, corn, or barley).

Most whiskeys are aged in wooden casks before bottling and have a minimum 40 percent alcohol by volume (ABV).

There are many different whiskey types, usually distinguished by their place of origin, types of grain, blending process, or the aging process.

While each whiskey type varies in flavor, the spirit is commonly described as warm, spicy, sweet, caramelly, or toasty.

Uisge beatha / The Water of Life / Scotch Whisky... Whatever you call Scotland's national drink, and whichever Scotch you discover, you know that it is a product of quality, crafted in Scotland, with a unique heritage stretching back more than 500 years.

SPEYSIDE

The most densely populated Whisky region in the world, famous for fertile glens and, of course, the River Spey. Speyside whiskies are known for being frugal with peat and full of fruit. Apple, pear, honey, vanilla and spice all have a part a role in expressions from this region, which are commonly matured in sherry casks.

TRELAND

Irish Whiskey is a mash of cereal grains, fermented, distilled and matured for a minimum of three years inside wood casks on the Island of Ireland. The four types of Irish Whiskey are Single Malt Irish Whiskey (both peated and unpeated), Single Grain Irish Whiskey, Single Pot Still Irish Whiskey and Blended Irish Whiskey.

BLENDED

Blended Irish whiskey is a mixture of single malt whiskeys from either the same or different distilleries. This mixing technique allows the blender to reach a specific taste they require.

TRELAND SINGLE GRAIN

Single Grain Irish Whiskey is made from any combination of cereal grains, distilled in a column still with no greater than 30% of malted barley. It is a style of Irish Whiskey that is similar to American whiskeys.

NORTH AMERICA BOURBON

Bourbon is an American whiskey, recognized by the U.S. Congress as a distinctive product of the United States. That distinction brings responsibilities: bourbon must be made with at least 51% corn and stored in brand-new oak barrels that have been flame-charred. That sounds simple enough, but there are many more rules that govern the proof, aging in the barrel time, bottling, labeling, mixing and more.

NORTH AMERICA RYE

Rye whiskey is made with a mash that must be at least 51% rye, the same rye that is used in rye bread. The resulting whiskey has a spicier flavor than bourbon.

NORTH AMERICA TENNESSEE

Bourbon and Tennessee whiskey are nearly identical. Both are American-made distilled spirits that have regulations regarding production. Bourbon—of which neighboring Kentucky is most famous for—can actually be produced anywhere within the United States, where Tennessee whiskey is exclusive to the state. Both whiskeys require the same corn percentage in the mashbill and must be aged in new charred oak barrels. The primary difference is that Tennessee whiskey must go through a charcoal filtering process, which mellows the whiskey's character.

NORTH AMERICA CANADIAN

Canadian whisky must contain alcohol distillate made from cereal grain that's mashed and distilled. It must age in small wood for at least three years in Canada. Finally, it must contain no less than 40% alcohol by volume—that's really about it. This gives Canadian whisky blenders a rare luxury in the whisky world for innovation without excessive restrictions backing them into a corner.

International

Navigating the complicated world of whisky can be tricky. Whisky can be defined as the fermentation of grains, distillation and maturation in oak casks, but this loose description leaves plenty of room for creativity. The varied types and flavours of whisky produced around the world attest to this. Whisky is, most famously, produced in Scotland, Ireland and North American but also in more than 100 countries, including Japan and Australia, having their own unique kinds of whisky.

AUSTRALIA

The rules around what constitutes a whisk(e)y in Australia are not as well defined as in some countries. The short version is it has to be a spirit made from cereal grain that smells, tastes and looks like whisk(e) y that has been aged in wood for at least 2 years (no specific mention of oak strangely).

Whisk(e)y in Australia can legally be bottled as low as 37% ABV (compared with a minimum of 40% ABV in the US and UK) - the low ABV in Australia apparently a holdover from the early 1900's due to war rationing and the temperance movement). These loose regulations have allowed for some 'innovative' or 'blasphemous' whiskies to emerge on the local scene depending on your point of view.

INTERNATIONAL JAPAN

With only about a dozen whisky distilleries in the entire country, Japanese whisky makers simply haven't been able to keep up with the increasing demand over the past decade. Many distillers have taken to blending their product with whisky bought from overseas in order to make supplies last longer.

From April 1, 2021 new rules governing Japanese whisky came into effect. The spirit must be fermented, distilled and aged at a distillery in Japan containing malted grain (eg barley, wheat, rye), but other non-malted cereal grains can also be included, water used to make the spirit must be extracted in Japan and the spirit must be aged for at least three years and bottled in Japan.
